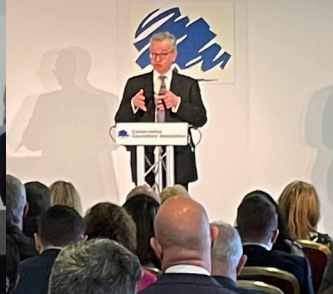

CONFERENCE INFORMATION

The 2025 Conservative Local Government Conference will be held on Friday 21st February to Saturday 22nd February 2025 at the Oxford Belfry in Oxfordshire.

The Conference provides excellent sponsorship and exhibition opportunities at an affordable cost. All rates include a generous advertisement in the Conference Programme, free of charge, and complimentary conference passes (dependent on sponsorship level and availability).

Our venue for 2024 is the 4* Oxford Belfry hotel in Thame, Oxfordshire. We have used this venue several times in the past and know that it works really well for our Conference with excellent attendance rates when we've used this venue previously.

Please be aware that sponsorship of a CCA event is considered a political donation, and (a) a company should have shareholder approval if donating over £5,000, and (b) if the value is over £11,180 the CCA will be required to declare this to the Electoral Commission within 30 days of the money being received by the CCA. The Commission will publish this on their website.

Rates for Sessions and Additional Events

Plenary Sessions (AV included)

45 minutes to the full delegate audience in the main Conference room. **£3250**
Includes a speaking opportunity (e.g. as a panelist), logo and name on the main screen, branding opportunities e.g. banner stand on stage.

Workshop Sessions (AV included; must bring own laptop if required)

50 mins for each session - this allows for two sessions, back-to-back, **£2500**
following an audience changeover. Includes a speaking opportunity, branding opportunities e.g. banner stands and literature in the meeting room, logo and name on the screen if using AV.
